**COMPETENCIES**

Primary responsibilities

- Follow BCPS Health & Safety Standard Operating Procedures for disinfecting classrooms.
- Sweep and mop floors.
- Clean buildings by emptying trash, sweeping, and cleaning surfaces.
- Clean and disinfect laboratory equipment.
- Restock supplies in bathrooms, break rooms, and common areas.
- Monitor building security and safety by performing such tasks as locking doors after operating hours and checking electrical appliance use to ensure that hazards are not created.
- Steam-clean carpets.
- Use cleaning solutions to remove stains and clean surfaces.
- Clean windows, glass, and mirrors, dust furniture and scrub surfaces clean.
- Apply wax to coat floors and buff.
- Apply sealant to floors.
- Clean and service restrooms with mops and disinfectants.
- Move heavy equipment and furniture.
- Identify and report possible repairs.

Demonstrate ability to:

- Knowledge of cleaning chemicals and supplies.
- Take initiative and work independently.
- Be flexible and adjust to changing priorities and schedules.
- Serve with a high level of integrity, commitment and reliability.
- Effectively communicate orally.
- Ability to handle heavy equipment and machinery.
